



### **2014 Corra Tail Feathers, Rogue Valley**

Growing up in the Rogue Valley surrounded by the pear orchards for which Southern Oregon is well known, I learned early on that inhaling the sweet perfume of an orchard in full bloom was sheer bliss. In creating this unique blend of aromatic white varieties, I've done my best to recreate that light yet intoxicating perfume of my childhood.

Grown on the banks of the Applegate River in the Rogue Valley, this crisp, dry white wine combines Viognier, Riesling, Marsanne and Rousanne to create a complex aromatic profile of guava, jasmine, fresh lemon zest, wet stone, and just a hint of sweet dew-laden field grasses. The mouthfeel is light-bodied, with enough acidity to be refreshing yet a soft, airy texture that adds a sense of grace and elegance.
