2013 Corra Cabernet Sauvignon

In a very few, very lucky years, all the stars align and Napa Valley collectively hits the ball out of the park. The 2013 Corra Cabernet continues its tradition of combining fruit from three of Napa's best growing areas (Pritchard Hill, Rutherford, and Oakville), and in this growing season each one of these areas created wines that were, as individual lots, abundant with deep ripe concentration and intensity. Combined, their individual traits are magnified.

Tasting Notes:

The 2013 Corra Cabernet Sauvignon shows lovely dark currants, blackberries, boysenberry syrup, floral notes, and just a touch of white pepper and fresh earth aromas. This wine is driven by purple fruit tones, but deep base notes add a note of depth and complexity to both the aromas and the palate. Rich and round at entry, the mid-palate receives a boost of volume, then very soft tannins showcase the fruit-driven finish. This is one of the densest, most concentrated Corra Cabernets yet from this combination of three distinctive sites in Napa Valley.

A total of 400 cases were produced.
