### **2014 Corra Cabernet Sauvignon**

Aromas of blackberry jam, cassis, dusty raspberries, dark cocoa and baked cherry pie all swirl and combine in the glass to create an interesting and evocative aroma profile in this very ripe Napa Cabernet. Touches of citrus zest, cinnamon, black pepper and a touch of sweet earth add slightly deeper base notes to the aromas. At entry, the wine is fresh and laden with dark cherry and blackberry flavors. Soft tannins are evident at entry and throughout the palate impression, with a bright acidity noted at the finish as the fresh cherry flavors fade.

This wine is crafted by carefully blending Cabernet Sauvignon grown in three of Napa Valley's most highly respected growing regions; the benchlands of Rutherford and of Oakville, as well as the west-facing slopes of Pritchard Hill. The grapes are hand harvested, destemmed, fermented on skins for an average of 21 days, then aged in French oak barrels (90% new) for 21 months prior to bottling. The wine is bottled without fining or filtration.

A total of 400 cases were produced.
