2007 Corra Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2007 Corra Cabernet Sauvignon displays provocative aromas of spiced raspberry and ripe blackberry, sweet tea, vanilla, cinnamon and sage notes, intermixed with a touch of cocoa/mocha adding depth to the gloriously sweet fruit. On the palate, this multi-dimensional wine offers a full, luscious entry with impressive concentration, displaying all the ripe blackberry and cherry intensity that is characteristic of the 2007 vintage. The mid-palate is full, rich, and opulent, supported by a harmonious tannin profile that is structural as well as silky. The juicy fruit flavors are pure and vibrant, with dark cherry notes that linger on the seductive finish.

The 2007 Corra Cabernet was crafted from vineyards on Pritchard Hill, in Rutherford, and in Oakville. The fruit, 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, was harvested between September 4 and October 1, 2007. The fruit was entirely hand-harvested, then double-sorted prior to fermentation. The fermentations were extended to about 28 days total maceration, then gently pressed and put to barrels for about 22 months in small French barrels (90% new.)

The wine was bottled in July 2009 without fining or filtration. A total of 375 cases were produced.
